In Upper Elementary we've been enjoying our studies of **Arizona**, **The Scientific Method**, and **Narrative Writing**. The student work that we're seeing each week is impressive! It seems like everyone is getting a lot done, and enjoying the creative process of synthesizing new knowledge.

We're learning how to **build community** over Zoom by playing games, having free time in break out rooms with friends, and reading the best-ever read aloud book: Wonder, by R. J. Palacio. The students are resilient and delightful as usual, and it's been amazing

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how much fun we can have on our screens together!

Next up we'll be studying the **Engineering Design Process**, **Simple Machines**, **Informative Writing**, and the rich culture and history of **Mexico**. Translating the Montessori hands-on philosophy to the At-Home Learning packets and schedules has been surprisingly inspiring. Miniaturizing our classroom materials, sending little hands-on pieces as much as we can, and really trusting the self-direction of the students has continued to deepen our faith and commitment to the Montessori learning process.

6th Avenue (Preschool & Kindergarten)

What a year! It's exciting to have the preschoolers in person, and it helps to create a sense of community that continues into the afternoon with our kindergarteners on Zoom. We have been exploring our world beginning with Living/Non-living, Plant/Animal, and Vertebrates/Invertebrates, all while learning how to navigate new technologies for at home learning!



We love singing with Bruce on Friday mornings (Reminder: join us at 9am!) and our kindergarteners enjoy story time with Lil on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays (Reminder: join us at 11am or 11:30am!). We appreciate the help and support of our families during this interesting time!

AZ SCHOOL TAX CREDIT INFORMATION

Thank you to all the families who have already re-directed their AZ taxes to our school. These are dollars well spent on our abundant safety precautions and extra technology during this time, as well as on the extracurricular activites we can provide virtually.
