#### A note on our chess program from Coach Ken:

The chess players at The Montessori Schoolhouse were also very active in chess tournaments this year. Fully eight players competed in one or more events: Elliana Matthewson, Kyrie Knapp, Jack Tuell, Jack Humphreys, Daniyal Awais, Shivank Manga, Steve Wadsworth and Maeli Johnson. As individual competitors in these scholastic matches, our players took home a total of eight ribbons, two medals, and six trophies. The trophy awards went to Jack T. in the first League Match, Jack H. in the second, Shivank twice in League Match #2 and the Tucson Scholastics State Qualifier, and Daniyal twice as well. Dani's two awards were quite substantial: 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Tucson Scholastics, and 20<sup>th</sup> overall in the State Championships! *As a team, The Montessori Schoolhouse netted no less than five trophy awards, and one for 11<sup>th</sup> in the State!* Quite a strong year!
