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Later, we will examine Earth's different **Biomes**: ocean, desert, forest, etc. We are just starting to build a **Temperate Forest Basket** so if you have any objects to donate, we would love them (model trees, raccoons, hedgehogs, squirrels, deer, etc.).

Our **Geography and Culture** series always begins with some aspect of **USA History**. So, we have touched on **Native Americans** with our rich **Object Basket** and the legend of the **3 Sisters** going for a moonlit walk and turning into corn, beans and squash. We soon will head further west in covered wagons with the **Pioneers**, then down to **Kenya**, **Africa** for safari...!

### **UPPER ELEMENTARY**

Upper Elementary started our first **History** unit focusing on the **American Revolution**! Beginning with a history of events including the Boston Tea Party, and moving into what a democracy is, are just some of the topics being discussed. We are also excited to introduce a deeper look in to the role of **Alexander Hamilton** during the Revolution, and present what an important background figure he truly was.

In **Science**, the Upper Elementary has been on a journey of the Earth with lessons such as **Layers of the Earth**, **Types of Rocks**, **The Rock Cycle**, and **Soil**. The next lesson will be **Botany**. All these topics will be the background we need to begin our hands-on experiments with plants in the classroom, but first, we'll practice **The Scientific Method**!

In **Language**, the students have been practicing the building blocks of writing. We began with jobs such as **Writing Complete Sentences**, **The Paragraph Sandwich**, **Elements of a Story**, **Components of a Plot**, as well as **Nouns**, **Verbs**, **and Adjectives**, to name a few. These lessons have culminated in weekly writing exercises ranging from sentences, to paragraphs, to narratives.

In **Math**, the Upper Elementary has been practicing all the operations: **Addition**, **Subtraction**, **Multiplication**, and **Division**. The 3<sup>rd</sup> graders have recently learned the **Properties of Math**, while the 4ths and 5<sup>ths</sup> have worked with **The Order of Operations**, **Area Model Multiplication** and **Division**.

**Choir** is in full swing! We are enjoying singing together on Fridays. We have 50 voices altogether, and it's fabulous. *Our Winter Concert will come in January*. In the mean-time, we'll be ordering choir t-shirts. Orders coming soon!

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# A Few Reminders...

#### **WATER BOTTLES:**

We understand and support your desire to keep your child hydrated in our dry Sonoran desert. But the school has plenty of water fountains everywhere, inside and out. PLEASE DO **NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL WITH LARGE WATER BOTTLES**. ANY DRINKS, WATER INCLUDED, MUST BE CONTAINED <u>INSIDE</u> LUNCHBOXES. Loose water bottles can pose a danger from spilled water on floor to tripping over the bottles themselves.

#### DROP-OFF:

If you are dropping off your child and the gate is closed, you must walk your child all the way in AND sign them in. Assisted Drop-Off is offered from 8:15-8:45 each day.

#### PICK-UP:

Please remember to pick up your child **ON TIME**.

Lower Elementary pick-up time is 2:15-2:30.

Upper Elementary pick-up time is 2:30-2:45.

#### LATE DROP OFF/LATE PICK\_UP:

Please be aware that <u>chronic late drop-offs and pick-ups are a distraction</u> to everyone, especially to the Morning Circle presentation, but also to the AfterSchool Circle as well. Please check your own time and arrive with-in the time frames designated above.

#### **PARKING COURTESY:**

If you are utilizing Carlos' lot across the street please only park along Mountain Ave. Do not park in front of his business or close to his buildings in any way.

#### **PIANO AND VIOLIN LESSONS:**

We are so happy to be able to continue to offer piano and violin lessons. A notice was sent out to all music parents with music teacher contact information and the responsibilities the parents have regarding these lessons. If you did not get a letter, please contact Rosemary for a copy. Please remember that if your child is not participating in the AfterSchool program, you need to be waiting for them after their lesson. Your child should not be rejoining the AfterSchool program after their lesson if they are not scheduled to attend.
